Tabbed Book



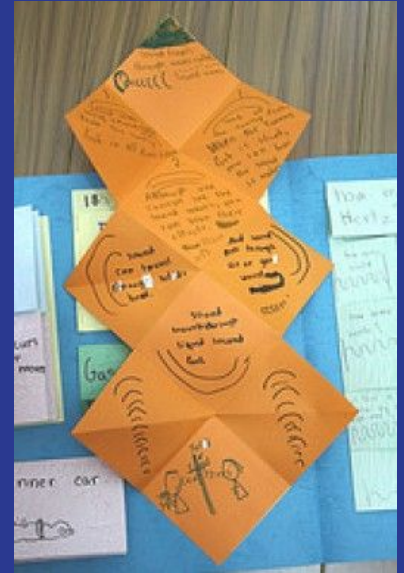
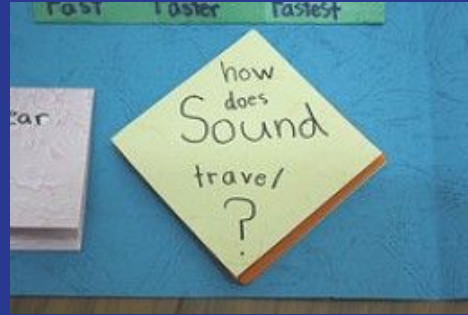
Tabbed Book Examples
